Introspection, Rumination, and Me

My son was working on an art project that expressed who he was, and so he asked me how I would describe him. He didn't mean his physical features like brown hair, tall, or male, as one can easily look into a mirror for those things. He wanted words that described his innerness. The kind of words that proves a little trickier for most people.

I easily rattled off my descriptive words, and he was off to create with a validated enthusiasm. However, his question made me think. How would I describe myself? It was not easy and I stumbled and tripped and didn't get very far. Did he also hesitate? Is that why he asked me to help him define himself?

So I asked if he felt that the words I used to describe him were accurate. He confirmed they were. I asked why if he knew, he asked me? He spoke my own inner thoughts. Thoughts, like undeserving, unworthy, bragging, and insecurity of the true self. I believe a good many of us

struggle with the same issues. Who are we beyond the mirror image? What are our deeper descriptive words?

I likened this experience to a book. Upon merely picking up a book, I could quickly and easily describe it based on its cover: blue cover, heavy, 5 by 8 inches, the title and author, or if it is a story or picture book. That is the easy part, like the human looking in the mirror. To describe anything else, I would have to become involved in the book and immerse myself beyond the cover. Then I could build the character, describe emotion playing out, understand the scenario, or visualize the scenery. The inside would take time to engage more fully. So I ask, how often do we engage in ourselves like that?

As is often the case, my child taught me again. He confirmed how we skim over ourselves due to truths we don't allow ourselves to see. Perhaps because we hesitate from insecurity, or our deeper reveals get hurried along due to the

speed of living, or because they get smothered by another's careless word or put-down.

So as he painted, I sat and got quiet, took deep breaths, engaged in my pages. I sat in introspection. I allowed rumination. I found me. Descriptive words that showed the good, bad, and ugly parts of thyself emerged but not in a judgmental way. It was soft and reflective. It allowed moments to complement myself, and insightful moments into things I needed to change. It was also very encouraging in how this introspection played out in the days and weeks that followed. More and more descriptive words flowed freely. I wasn't stumbling or tripping but strolling smoothly into the deeper self.

My son created his physical piece of art that day, and I created a deeper more personal piece of inner art myself. Introspection, rumination and me is the contribution we all can create.

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Book Review of

School of the Soul, Its Path and Pitfalls written by Z'ev ben Shimon Halevi

Ze'v ben Shimon Halevi (English name, Warren Kenton) is an author of books on the Toledano Tradition of Kabbalah. He has taught the discipline for over 40 years, has a worldwide following, and is the founding member of the Kabbalah Society. Along with Kabbalah, he has authored several texts on astrology. His books focus on how to manifest the full potential of the soul within the various the planes of existence. Students of Rev. June K. Burke and the Seraph Julian will likely resonate deeply with Warren Kenton's works as the teachings harmonize beautifully together. There is no need to embark on an in depth study of Kabbalah to gain tremendous insights from Halevi's work. His writings are clear and precise. He leads the reader to greater understanding of the purpose and process of creation, and how to quicken our growth through self-awareness and the conscious use of will.

New editions of Halevi's main works have recently been released and include new diagrams, symbols, and illustrations that provide added insights into the text. I highly recommend the new editions. They are available through Halevi's website, http://www.kabbalahsociety.org/ which links you to Watkins Bookstore in London (one of the premier metaphysical bookstore in the world). The older editions are less expensive and readily available through Amazon.com, Barnes and Noble, and other popular bookstores.

For this article, I chose to spotlight Halevi's book, School of the Soul, Its Path and Pitfalls. This unique text explains the workings of esoteric groups, which Halevi refers to as "schools of the soul". The book provides practical information that applies to Julian community members as we study and grow together. Topics include why such schools are important, how they are successfully created and maintained, along with the pitfalls and problems to be mindful of.

It is helpful to have this guidance when forming and growing a study group. As students and teachers of the June/Julian work, this book provides a broad perspec-

tive of our place in the process of evolution, as we identify with esoteric students throughout time. You will see how your life path is similar to others from different spiritual traditions, various cultures and ages throughout time, all on an esoteric quest. To paraphrase Halevi from Chapter 2:

"It has been said that one in a hundred people is interested in spiritual development, but that only one in a hundred of these holds to the Path and carries it through to the end of his or her life. This means that only one in ten thousand people walking on the planet Earth is involved in the esoteric life of the planet. Even so, this adds up to quite a number. How is it done? It begins when a person is no longer concerned with just physical survival or asserting an egotistical impression on society, but wish to know why they are here on Earth. The first contact between a seeker and the Work, as it is sometimes called, is usually within their own culture and they seek within the tradition they were raised. Yet very often the individual seeker is left dissatisfied here, and having rejected his or her own cultural background finds a resonance in an alien tradition. This for many is the entry point into a new spiritual family."


Most of us in the Julian community realize we have moved off the beaten track in terms of our keen interest in esoteric studies. Although we share a love of humanity, we have developed a set values and priorities that differs from many in the popular culture. In addition, many of us broke away from our childhood religious training or from the family culture within which we were raised and chose to follow an "alien tradition" as Halevi refers to it. Alien here refers to something foreign or unfamiliar with our early training.

This divergence required courage and strength of will. Many of us had to step away from the belief systems our family, our friends, and our community. Although we may love and respect them, we follow the beat of a different drummer.

In Chapter 7, Halevi explains the importance of group work. Once again paraphrase:

"In former times an individual who sought spiritual instruction could go to a recognizable school for the soul. They attend because they wish to pursue a path of intimate knowledge of God and for them nothing less than a direct contact will do. However, before this stage can be reached several insights about groups are gained. The first is the realization that one cannot develop alone. No amount of effort will take one beyond the range of ego. The person who has read every book on the subject but has no one to debate with soon forms a fixed set of unchallenged views."

Halevi explains that working with others in a group forms a dynamic of discussion and sharing that can help a person elevate through the prejudices of their own ego to a higher consciousness. And, that participation in the daily rigors of the world provides needed lessons in establishing inner balance, as well as opportunities to



apply the teachings. This is not as easily attained if one isolates themselves from the world, even if in prayer and meditation.

By providing a step-by-step guide to esoteric group work, Halevi can assist the Julian community teachers and students in their own group participation. The book applies whether you study June & Julian Teachings, Kabbalah, Buddhism or any other spiritual study. Halevi concludes that no matter what esoteric line of teaching you choose:

"The Teaching has no special conditions other than that Truth should manifest in the presence of an honest seeker. Through it we learn how to come to terms with fate and to meet our spiritual destiny. Within the context of a group we can recognize our unique identity and relate the gifts we have been given to the other's skills, not in the competitive way of the world, but as each person fits into his own particular place in the school, which is part of a whole that, in turn, is an element in a larger scheme and so on, until we see every everything is interconnected in time and manifestation.

Existence is the unfoldment of the Holy Name I AM THAT I AM... Our task is to realize, in each of our lives, the God Consciousness that lies at the root of our being and pervades the universe. Schools ... are brought into being to aid this process and place it in the widest and deepest context, so that we may gaze, and in our moment of enlightenment, upon the countenance of the inner and outer Worlds, and realize WHO beholds WHO."

Thank you for taking the time to read this article. I welcome your feedback on it, and on the concept of bringing the works of authors complimentary to those of June and Julian into the ROL.

Also, perhaps there is interest in having an ROL Book Club of sorts, where some of you choose to read, say, School of the Soul and would like ongoing articles in the next few ROL issues about its content. You could submit your questions, observations and comments about the book and we could have a forum. This same format could be applied to other teachings, especially June/Julian materials. The History of the Universe (Workshop #201)

Chapter VII: CRYSTAL POWER

We have spoken about the gradual growth of the Atlantean period from that which was similar to primate man to that which was highly technically involved. As in many cases, when something good is discovered — a word, a power, or any good thing — it can be overemphasized until it becomes a negative. You have some words in your society that, originally, were very expressive of a particular thing and then became so over-used that they are now a drudge to the ears of anyone who hears them. You have powers that have come into your plane that have been thought to be very good, but when over-used, have gotten out of hand and become a problem. And so it was in the Atlantean period.

When crystal power was discovered, the desire to play with them initiated the chain of events that followed. The crystals were porous, very similar to your granite, but with much larger pores. Each small pore was a chamber which created the ricocheting and amplifying of sound, bringing it to harmonics which were very pleasant and very amusing. At first, crystals were used as what you call "wind chimes." They were used to create phonetic harmony for amusement.

The Atlanteans began to find that, in some of the areas in which these were used, vegetation was affected. They began to discover that people were affected. The crystals began to become the "highs," so to speak, and people would gather to use them as a mesmeric force, bringing themselves to a great high, still for amusement, not with the thought of using them in a constructive manner.

As they began to discover that these powers, these sounds, these phonetic vibrations had this effect upon them, they began to experiment with the effect it had on other things. The scientific mind began to work with the crystals. They began to polish them and to bring them together in certain configurations and patterns, and observed that tremendous force could be brought forth from them.

This, then, took on a dual role. There were those who took the sound phonetics and created what you call la-

ser beam. From refracted light and sound, they created healing patterns that were used medically with certain sounds opening a wound and certain sounds closing it.

It should be recognized that the high piercing sounds were used for the opening and the lower vibration sounds were used for the closing. If any of you are involved in music, you can work with those scales and begin to feel what happens as sound is elevated. As the vibration is brought to higher pitches, it has a more piercing quality, a quality that sometimes creates involuntary opening.

So the crystal power was being used for medical purposes as well as to induce plant growth and, in some cases, to retard it.

They then decided that, if the power of one was good, the power of ten would be better, and they increased the power. About the time that the power was becoming a very strong force, they began to realize that, while they had created a means to start the vibration, they did not know how to stop it. The crystals would continue to vibrate whether they were in actual use or not.

This created problems because whole sound barriers, sound waves and forces that interacted with each other, were constantly going on without any purpose or use. It became a fearful thing; it was a natural force which was out of control. They came upon the idea that they could break the crystals and bury them. Certainly, if the harmonic was fragmented, the crystals would be separated and could not interact. However, they simply acted on their own at whatever point of harmony or discord they were

The buried particles continued to vibrate and emanate their sound and power. Gradually, they honeycombed the entire land masses in which they were buried, permitting the sea to enter and weaken the structure, which later contributed to the sinking of Atlantis. It was a pure honey-comb with the sea going through it beneath the surface.

The point is that power was put into play here that was not properly governed. Does this sound familiar? The

crystals were like a fungus. The power would create a channel and then, as they moved slightly, another would be created. When Atlantis rises, some of these crystals will still be vibrating. Many of them have been subdued by "the pacifier", the sea. The sea has always been the pacifier, the purifier, has always been that which heals; but there will be some fragments of the crystals that will still be vibrating.

The nullification of these vibrational energies should have been done by altering the vibration itself. The vibration had been brought constantly up, until it was a very high pitch, a penetrating and cutting pitch. It could be modified by changing the phonetics, by changing the aperture, by dulling the surface.

Collectively, these things would have gradually nullified the power. They did not think any farther until it became so strong that they were fearful of it. Their one solution was: If you have something you do not like, destroy it by breaking it. Whether emotional or physical, it was a breaking as far as they were concerned.

They did not realize that separating or fragmenting the phonetic altered it to some degree but that there were enough collective phonetics that continued to hold the power. If you position a mirror so that sun rays are hitting it, it is going to reflect with a very strong power. The only way to lower the power is to dim that which reflects on the mirror or alter the surface on which it is reflected.

There was not enough consideration put into the altering of the reflector; they thought that just fragmenting the crystal would be enough

All during this period of gain, control and power-play with these crystals, there were those who worked with the spiritual aspect. Here, again, the spiritual elevation of consciousness, the raising of the levels of the mind for healing purposes, comprehension of the universe and interaction with nature got out of hand.

There were those who thought: If my mind can do this, it can also get me anything I want. I can use it as a control factor. The negative factor was again brought into it. Ego and personality got in the way of spiritual elevation. Thus you had the parallel of many avenues of good gradually becoming negatives because of the misuse of power, the power of the mind, the power of the spirit and the power of the crystals. It was a spiritual, a physical and a mental thing, all being used at very high consciousness levels and then moving to negative and destructive ones. If negativity is being built by power plays on the surface and, underneath the ground, powers are destruc-

tively honey-combing your continent, you have a "double whammy", as you call it in your world. No matter whether anyone realizes it or not, man power and cosmic power do affect each other.

The powers of nature, of cosmos and of man must work together collectively in order to have a true harmonic. When man gets to the point where he is not creating a harmonic that can be worked with, natural forces take over — not to destroy man, but to again reinstate the balance.

There are many parallels between the Atlantean period and the time you are living in right now. Technology has once again reached a very high focus. You are playing with what is called "atomic power" as they played with crystal power. By the time they got done with it, the power of the crystals had the same force and magnitude as that of atoms. It is not that crystal power in itself was bad; it is not that atomic power in itself is bad; it is how it is handled, how it is used, how it is directed.

Man is at the point now where his thinking is pointing to spiritual things and this is the saving factor. The balance the Network of Light builds by that spiritual attribute will begin to convert the negative attitudes of man. Much of the negativity in your world today is the catalyst for change. Man has a habit of being slow in dealing with something that is not an immediate necessity. For example, man looked for alternate power when his back was to the wall. Alternate power should have been searched for long before it became a crisis. That does not mean they cannot change it; that does not mean they cannot be the victor. If man will work in harmony with nature and each other, you will have modification of cosmic forces. That is as simple as LOVING ONE AN-OTHER UNCONDITIONALLY. That is your New Age Commandment, so to speak.

You notice I slip that one in whenever I can. It does not matter what the subject, I can always work it around to LOVING ONE ANOTHER UNCONDITIONALLY, because, my friends, it is so important! Unconditionally does not mean one becoming subservient to the other or having to agree on everything. It means you are willing to be and let be; you are willing to interact with everything in the universe. When that happens, there are no less; there are no better. There are only people, and that has nothing to do with self-esteem or the desire to achieve. It is recognizing that one can achieve without stepping on others, without undermining someone else. Spirituality was at its height in Atlantis in the third quadrant and at the beginning of the fourth. By the midfourth quarter, everything had begun to go "down hill".
