Why do we look to the planets? Astro is a predictive tool that has withstood the test of time.

Planets deliver the energies from the universe that push and prod us to evolve.

Transits

Ongoing movement of planets as they orbit the Sun

Forecast trends, timing, potential developments

Aspects - the angular relationships between planets

Constantly change as the planet transits

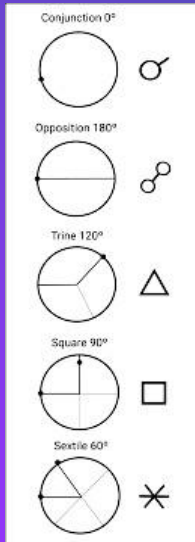
Growth through ease and harmony, or challenges

You don't need to understand transits or aspects to gain from this class. For those of you who know astrology, you'll find the technical terms helpful. Transits refer to the ongoing movement of planets as they orbit the Sun. We astrologers use transits as our main method to forecast trends, timing of events, and potential developments in the world and in an individual's life. So, we say, Pluto has moved from the sign of Capricorn into the sign of Aquarius... and that changes how Pluto expresses itself.

As the planets move, they form *aspects*—angular relationships to one another—that influence how their energies are expressed. Aspects constantly change as planets orbit around the Sun. For example, as Pluto moves through the sign of Aquarius, it will align with or aspect the planet Uranus.

Aspects influence how a planet expresses itself. Aspects encourage growth through ease and harmony, or through challenges.

Five Major Aspects



Conjunction: Strengthen, empower, amplify

Opposition: Challenge, must reconcile, integrate

Trine: Harmony, ease, supportive w/o much effort

Square: Challenges, friction, tension to overcome

Sextile: Harmony, opportunity, subtle, requires effort

The five main aspects of astrology are:

- Conjunction (0°): When two or more planets occupy the same or close degrees, their energies merge. They amplify and empower each other.
- Opposition (180°): This challenging aspect occurs when planets are directly across from each other. There's a need for balance and integration of opposing energies. For example, you like to go on vacation, I'm a homebody. How are we going to make this relationship work?
- Trine (120°): A very harmonious aspect that brings ease & flow without much effort on your part. The planets involved support and strengthen each other.
- Square (90°): Challenging. It creates friction and tension to overcome.
- Sextile (60°): A harmonious aspect that brings opportunities and flow. A bit more subtle than a trine, some effort is required to make the most of it.

Denise and I will explain four major transits unfolding now, and what we might expect over the next few years as a result.

Pluto in Aquarius trine Uranus in Gemini 2024 - 2030

The first significant alignment is between Pluto and Uranus. These two powerhouse planets will form a trine, a harmonious aspect where their energies flow easily together.

Pluto: Lord of the Underworld

Pluto transforms through destruction, death, and eventual rebirth. It deals with unveiling. It brings buried psychological issues and deeply held desires to the surface—some desires good and some not so good. On its shadow side, Pluto fuels a ruthless drive for power, domination, and even the violent use of force.

Pluto brings poisons and blockages into the light to be acknowledged, addressed, and ultimately healed. It also brings up untapped potential, courage, and strength to be used.

I use the visualization of a volcano to describe Pluto's effects because Pluto eruptions, like those of a volcano, devastate the land. But out of that devastation, new nutrients are brought up – the mountainside eventually becomes lush with new growth. Our untapped potentials are brought to the surface to be used.

Uranus: The Great Awakener



Rebellion for freedom
Disrupts the status quo
Innovation and creativity
The unexpected and unusual
Emotionally detached
Shadow: erratic, reckless

Uranus, on the other hand, rules rebellion, revolution, and the pursuit of freedom. It brings disruption, breakthroughs, and innovation. I liken it to an earthquake, or a bolt of lightning from the heavens.

Its energy is electric, sudden and unpredictable. Called the Great Awakener, Uranus shakes the foundations of the familiar to create the new. It brings breakthroughs in technology, medicine and science.

Uranus is emotionally detached. It permits us to view things away from emotional embroilment. Its shadow brings a lack of empathy and compassion, along with erratic and reckless behavior.

Two Titans Fuel Each Other in a Trine

Pluto's power of destruction, death and rebirth fuels Uranus' drive for revolution, freedom and innovation

Uranus' detached drive for freedom amplifies the best or worst of Pluto's unveiling of psyche's underworld

Sparks the death and rebirth of global systems and structures, and personal behaviors and perspectives

Pluto and Uranus are the Titans. These are massive universal forces fueling each other. Their effect is transformation on a global scale. They are considered transpersonal planets because their impact is often more universal than personal.

Life moves in a spiral, with the same issues repeating again and again. By looking at how these two planets affected things in the past, we can anticipate what's ahead. So let's look at their recent history.

Pluto trines Uranus now. That means they harmonize and work well together. But that doesn't mean everything is rosy.

1920 - 1924 Pluto trine Uranus

Roaring Twenties: The Jazz Age & women's liberation

18th and 19th Amendments

Mussolini and Stalin come into power

The Chinese Communist Party and USSR are formed

Hilter begins his propaganda campaign

Insulin, Penicillin, TB, measles, diphtheria vaccines

First public radio broadcasts: mass communication born

Model T Ford and assembly line production

Tomb of Pharaoh Tutankhamun discovered

The last time these two were in trine was 100 yrs ago, between 1920 – 1924. Just after the Spanish Flu (similar to how we've just moved from the impact of COVID). We see the themes of freedom versus government control, along with innovation

Rebellion for rights and freedom:

- The Jazz Age, Roaring Twenties – freedom from Victorian lifestyle.
- Women wore more revealing clothes, were out in public dancing, smoking, and drinking. And enjoying more sexual freedom.
- In the US, the 19th Amendment passed & women gained right to vote

Issues of government power and control:

- The 18th Amendment banned alcohol
- Suppression of voting rights for Blacks through biased laws and threats of violence
- Dictators come into power in Italy, Russia and China, giving rise to millions of executions, the rich getting richer, and incredible suppression of the masses

- Adolf Hitler begins his propaganda campaign and his rise to power

Medicine: Discovery of insulin and penicillin. Vaccines are discovered for TB, measles, and diphtheria

Drug Use: With prohibition speakeasies were born – underground bars and dance clubs where lots of illegal alcohol and drugs were used

Technology: First public radio broadcasts – 1st mass communication

Transportation: Ford's Model T and assembly line production made cars affordable, giving freedom of travel to the masses

Unearthed treasures: The tomb of Tutankhamun is discovered

Pluto square Uranus 1929 - 1935

Stock market crash

Great depression

Hitler rises to power

**Over 1 million people were sent to
concentration camps**

Leads to WWII

The next time these two titans were in aspect was between 1929 - 1935, when they were square to each other.

Early 1960's: A New Cycle Begins

Pluto conjunct Uranus

Protests: women's liberation, civil & LGBTQ+ rights

Violence around voting rights

Birth control introduced, free love movement

IBM develops mainframe computer, Digital Age born

Increased drug use, especially weed and psychedelics

Innovations in music and the arts

Cuban Missile Crisis – a close call with nuclear war

Fast forward to the early 1960's a new cycle began with Pluto conjunct Uranus. Once again, we see Uranus' rebellion for rights and freedom combine with Pluto's energies of control & power.

- Rebellion for rights and freedom: Great protests and success in gaining women's liberation, civil rights, LGBTQ+ rights, and protests against the Vietnam War the helped to put an end to it
- Power and Control: govt attempts to control the protests
- Medicine: birth control pill was introduced – sexual revolution (as there was in the Roaring 20's)
- Increased drug use – Marijuana, psychedelics
- Technology: Mainframe computer invented, begins the Digital Age; Artificial Intelligence is born
- Transportation: We land on the moon
- Unearthed treasures: The discovery of the skeletons of the earliest humans
- As in the 1920's Jazz Age and Art Deco, we had major innovations in music and the arts
- Cuban Missile Crisis – a close call of nuclear war

2010 - 2017 Pluto square Uranus

MeToo movement, Gay marriage is legalized
Robotic surgery and use of artificial organs begins
Marijuana is legalized in many states
Artificial Intelligence accessible to general public
The Dead Sea Scrolls are discovered
2011 Nuclear Nonproliferation Agreement
Housing market crisis

The next big interaction of these two was the square from 2010 – 2017. Issues raised in the 1920's and 1960's came to the forefront again

- Protests: MeToo raised awareness of the abuse of women's and their rights. Gay marriage is legalized
- Medicine: Robotic surgery and use of artificial organs began
- Drug use: Marijuana legalized in many states, psychedelic use increases with magic mushrooms, and Brazilian Ayahuasca
- Technology: Artificial intelligence becomes accessible on a mass scale
- Unearthed treasures: The Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered
- Nuclear Nonproliferation Agreement: In the 1960s, we almost had a nuclear war and in 2011, an international agreement was made to prevent spread of nuclear weapons
- Financial crisis of 1929 is mirrored in the 2010 housing market crash

Saturn conjunct Neptune in Aries May 2025 thru March 2026

Thank you Camille. I so appreciate your perspective and wisdom. You make it so easy to understand!

So, let's talk about Saturn joining Neptune in the sign of Aries...The influence of this transit begins this month and will continue thru March of 2026. (not quite a year)

I'm going to break it down... First, we'll talk about the planetary energies of Saturn and Neptune individually and then how they each function in the sign of Aries...and then check out the combined effect of this transit.

Saturn

The Great Teacher and Manifestor



Restrictions, responsibilities, discipline, sacrifice, structure and form — keeper of time

Shadow: fear, guilt, pessimism and depression

Provides the lessons we need to understand and grow

Saturn is known as the Great Teacher and Manifestor.

- Kind of the old school “Mom” of the zodiac, she teaches us about restrictions and responsibilities, discipline and sacrifice, structure and form,.
- Saturn is also the keeper of time, making sure everything is going to work out in its proper time.
- Depending on your perspective of those things, you’ll either appreciate Saturn for the lessons she teaches or feel restrictions from her “tough-love”.
- On the shadow side, Saturn is also associated with fear, guilt, pessimism and depression.
- Saturn provides the lessons we’ve chosen that we need for our understanding and growth.

Neptune: The Dissolver

- Neptune is known as “the Dissolver”. Dissolving the boundaries. Dissolving reality as we see it.
- It’s really about being detached from reality...which can be expressed positively or negatively.
- On the positive side, it governs spirituality and mysticism, intuition and imagination, compassion and empathy.
- It supports inspiration, creative expression and our deepest healing.
- And on the other end of the spectrum, we may experience illusion, escapism, deception and addiction.

Saturn in Aries 5/25 – 4/28

- Saturn will be in the sign of Aries from the end of this month thru April, 2028.
- The restrictive energy of Saturn can feel at odds with Aries' fiery impulsiveness.
- So...during this period it may require extra effort to achieve balance and growth.
- Saturn governs discipline and Aries is about initiating new beginnings and self-assertion.
- Saturn's influence in Aries urges us to lay down solid, realistic plans building new foundations.
- The combination of these energies can foster healthy self-esteem and confidence.
- It's a perfect time to focus on physical fitness and vitality.
- The transit highlights themes of leadership, self-reliance, and personal responsibility.
- During this cycle which supports changes to authority and power structures, we will see pushes for reform and possibly the rise of new, more accountable leaders.
- Aries wants rapid progress; Saturn demands caution, patience and diligence.

- This can create tension or frustration, but it also teaches the value of perseverance and the rewards of slow, steady effort.

The last transit that we'll talk about combines the planets that Denise was talking about, Saturn and Neptune conjunct, how they will impact Pluto trine Uranus. And this is really important because when we look at the history of Pluto and Uranus, we know from now through 2030 we can expect radical social, political and economic change, likely with power concentrated in the hands of a few dominant leaders.

And, we're going to see a personal desire for spiritual growth, and to bring out our inner potentials and creativity. There will be a deep desire to express who we really are.

The energies are more favorable now than they were in the 1920s and 1960s. We may be facing many of the same issues that we had before, but with sextiles on our side, we can have very different outcomes. We have harmonic aspects between all four of these planets. Pluto and Uranus are sextile both Saturn and Neptune.

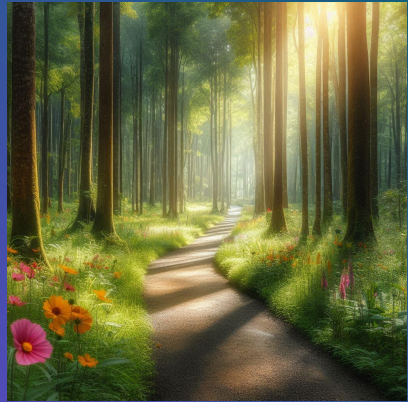
Boldly Create the Future
