**Planets are the delivery system for the
universal energies of evolution**

Thank you, Jan. Hello and welcome to you all. I'm glad you've joined us today. Denise and I have lots to share about the major planetary changes unfolding. Our greatest challenge in designing this program was to concisely present a vast amount of information. We could talk about the current energies all day – but will spare you that! Keeping it to one hour was no easy feat.

Why do we look at the planets' movement? Because astrology is a predictive tool that has withstood the test of time.

The planets are the delivery system for the universal energies of evolution. What that means is we're here on Earth to evolve, and what motivates us, what pushes and prods us to grow, are the universal energies that are delivered to us through the planets.

Remarkable and Uncommon Events

Three major evolutionary cycles are shifting

- 1. Round Change**
- 2. Age Change**
- 3. Earth Change**

Those of you who have attended my workshops in the past know that what's happening now is remarkable and uncommon. Three major evolutionary cycles are shifting at the same time. We've never experienced before this before. Underway we have a Round Change, an Age Change, and an Earth Change.

Round Change: Eons

3	5	3 rd & 5 th GLOBE	The Substantial (or Formative) Plane

Let's look at the concept of Round Change. In Wisdom Teachings, evolution unfolds in seven vast stages called Rounds. Each Round spans billions of years and marks major leaps in consciousness.

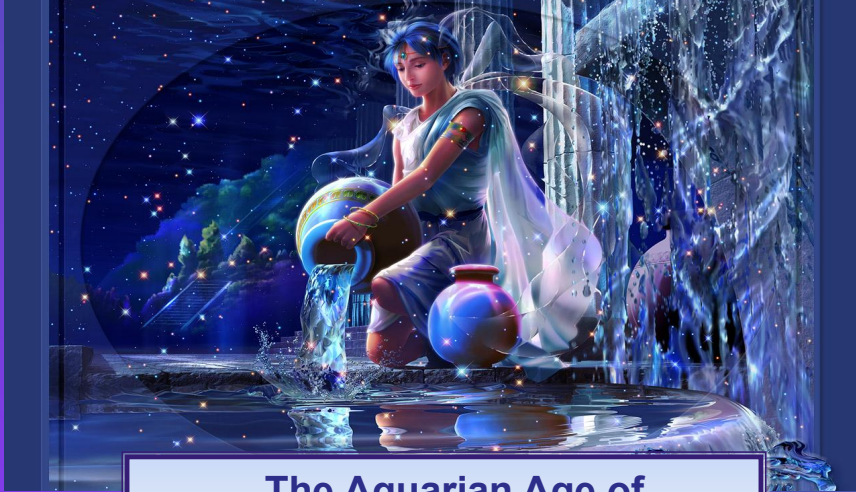
In the beginning, all was one. Then a great impulse—often called the Big Bang—set evolution into motion. Individual souls emerged during the first Round. We were born into manifestation.

During the first three Rounds we existed in the Light Body. We developed awareness of our senses, learned to communicate, and to interact with our environment.

The transition from the third to the fourth Round corresponds to Lemuria, a time when humanity moved fluidly between the Light Body and the physical form—shifting between heaven and earth with ease. The fourth Round, shown here in red, marks our descent into dense physical form. This is our present state, where consciousness is fully anchored in matter, and humanity primarily identifies with physical reality.

But, the ascent is beginning. We are now moving from the fourth to the fifth Round. Humanity is returning to the Light Body. This is a profoundly significant. We are becoming closer and closer to living consciously in our Light Body. As a result, we have greater access to our High Self and all things of the inner plane. We are on our way Home—carrying with us all the wisdom and experience gained along the way.

Age Change: 2600 years



The Aquarian Age of Enlightenment and Peace

The next major cycle is the Age Change. Each Age lasts about 2,600 years, and over the past few decades, we've transitioned from the Piscean Age into the Aquarian Age.

Pisces emphasized a belief that God exists outside of us. It was an era shaped by themes of sacrifice, discipline, and often the feeling of "I am not worthy."

Aquarius shifts that perspective. It teaches that the Divine lives within us—we are not separate. We are co-creators and one with the Divine.

As we move into this higher frequency, lower vibrations like fear and hatred cannot exist. Like ice melts in the sun, they dissolve in the presence of this greater Light, this higher vibration, making way for enlightenment and peace.

Earth Change: 3000 Years



- **Humanity functions by reason and intellect**
- **Nature functions by intuition**
- **Nature will do what it needs to self-perpetuate**

This next cycle unfolding is the Earth Change. Every 3000 years or so, Earth undergoes upheavals necessary to re-establish and replenish itself. This is why we are now experiencing dramatic landscape and climate change. While humanity functions by reason and intellect, nature is the wiser through intuition. Nature is going to do what it needs to do in order to perpetuate itself. We can either help or hinder this process by our actions.

Unprecedented Change

Four major planets shift signs in roughly a year

Pluto in Aquarius **11/24 – 1/44**

Neptune in Aries **1/26 – 3/39**

Uranus in Gemini **4/26 – 5/33**

Saturn in Aries **2/26 – 4/28**

Things are accelerating now. Within roughly one year, four outer planets have changed signs. This is extraordinarily rare.

Pluto moved from Capricorn into Aquarius, Neptune from Pisces into Aries, Uranus from Taurus into Gemini, and Saturn from Pisces into Aries.

Astrologers have tracked planetary cycles for thousands of years—and we've never seen so many slow-moving planets change signs this quickly. It marks a remarkable turning point for us all.

Pluto in Aquarius November 2024 – January 2044

Pluto moved into Aquarius in November, 2024 and remains there for 20 years.

Pluto: Lord of the Underworld



- **Volcanic power**
- **Brings up what's below the surface**
- **Reveals strengths and weaknesses**
- **Death and rebirth**
- **Transformation**

Pluto, the Lord of the Underworld, operates like a volcano. It brings what's hidden below the surface up and out into the open, often with intensity. It exposes poisons, weaknesses, and what's been repressed. Like a volcano erupts, Pluto transits can appear to devastate the land.

Yet, in this eruption, new nutrients are also brought to the surface. These foster new growth. Likewise, Pluto's upheaval uncovers hidden strengths and untapped potentials. Through the disruption comes new growth. This is the essence of Pluto: death and rebirth. And with that, transformation.

Let's look at how Pluto has shaped our world over time.

In the 1970s, Pluto was in Libra—Libra rules relationships. Pluto's transit through Libra transformed them. Divorce became more accepted, and more women entered the workforce. Even though these changes were highly disruptive and controversial at the time, relationships began shifting toward greater equality and personal fulfillment.

In the 1980s, Pluto moved into Scorpio, bringing deep transformation around sex and sexuality. The AIDS crisis connected sex with death—very much in Pluto's domain—while issues like sexual abuse and harassment were brought to the surface and came into public awareness. At the same time, sexuality became more visible in media, prompting both greater openness and regulation.

From 1995 to 2008, Pluto was in Sagittarius which rules religion and belief systems. Pluto in Sagittarius exposed corruption within some prominent organized religions. As result, many people turned away from their churches and religion, and moved toward a more personal spirituality. This gave rise to the idea of being “spiritual, not religious.”

When Pluto entered Capricorn in 2008, the focus shifted to transformation of structures—governments, institutions, and systems of authority. The housing crisis revealed deep instability, and since then, we've seen ongoing challenges to political and economic systems worldwide. These transformations will take some time to actualize.

Now Pluto has entered Aquarius, where it will remain for the next two decades. Here, we can expect transformation around technology, communication, and collective power. We will shift away from control by the few toward empowerment of the many.

Aquarius

Streams of New Thoughts



- **Air, fixed, “I Know”**
- **That which is new, unusual – expect the unexpected**
- **Rebellion for freedom and equality**
- **Progressive, innovative, youthful, forward-thinking**
- **Great advancements in technology**
- **Shadow: Rigid opinions, aloof, know-it-all attitude**

Aquarius is a fixed Air sign associated with new, unusual ideas. It rules streams of new thought. Its key phrase is, “I know.” It governs rebellion for freedom, along with innovation, advanced technology, and the future—everything progressive, unconventional, and forward-thinking. It also rules the collective.

In contrast to Capricorn’s focus on tradition, structure and limitation, Aquarius emphasizes youth, freedom, and all that’s new. Its shadow side can manifest as rigid opinions, emotional indifference, and a know-it-all attitude.

Pluto in Aquarius 1778-1798

Air travel began: First hot air balloon launched

Dramatic changes in world view:

Pluto was last in Aquarius 248 years ago, from 1778 to 1798. We can look to its impact then for clues as to what to expect of it now. During that time, major revolutions for the freedom, rights and equality of the collective reshaped the world: the French Revolution abolished the monarchy, the American Revolution established independence from Britain, forming the United States. The U.S. Constitution and Bill of Rights were created to secure basic freedoms.

Aquarius is an Air sign, and this period marked breakthroughs in movement and thought - both ruled by air. Air travel began with the first hot air balloon. In 1781, the Uranus was discovered breaking old boundaries of what we knew of our solar system. When Pluto was in Aquarius the time before, the 1500's, Copernicus discovered that the Sun, not earth, was center of our solar system, triggering a scientific revolution.

Pluto in Aquarius transforms the collective and dramatically shifts our worldview.

Pluto in Aquarius

11/24 – 1/44

- **Advances in technology accelerate:**
 - **AI, genetic engineering, and medicine**
 - **Technology and information wars, not physical**
- **Energy sourced from air and innovative sources**
- **Focus from “me” to “we” consciousness**
- **Communication with our galactic family**
- **Need for ethics to keep pace with advancements**

What can we expect this time around? Tremendous advancements in technology. AI will gain in sophistication beyond our imagination. Expect major breakthroughs in genetic engineering and medicine in general. Our battles shift from physical combat on the ground to technologically driven warfare. We'll see energy sourced from air, and because Aquarius rules innovation, other groundbreaking energy sources will be discovered. Our focus will change from “me” to “we” consciousness.

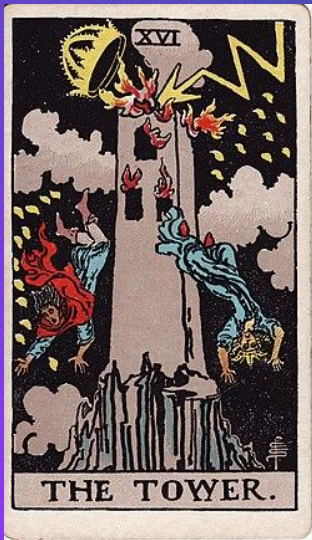
And as I've said for many years, we can expect global, conscious contact with our galactic family. This will have major impact on our technology and world view.

With technology advancing so rapidly, it's critical for us to ethically keep pace. As Julian said, what's happening now is parallel to what happened during the times of Atlantis. In Atlantis, ethics didn't keep pace with technology, and destruction ensued. We don't have to let that happen again.

Uranus in Gemini April 2026 – May 2033

Uranus was in Gemini briefly last year and then went retrograde back into Taurus. This April, Uranus re-entered Gemini, where it remains until May of 2033.

Uranus: The Great Awakener



- Sudden, unexpected change
- Freedom from blockages
- Personal transformation
- Rebellion, independence
- Innovation, creativity
- Social movements

Uranus, known as “the Great Awakener,” brings sudden, unexpected change. It often results in freedom—sometimes wanted, sometimes not. That’s why I chose the tarot Tower card to represent Uranus. Here, a lightning bolt from the heavens drives out the old rulers and will soon destroy the existing structure. Uranus destroys the existing pattern, making way for the new. Yet, as shocking as it is, this destruction is part of the Divine Plan, as something new is meant to unfold.

Associated with science, technology, and creativity, Uranus encourages original solutions and unconventional ideas. It rules rebellion and independence. It pushes us to challenge the status quo and supports social progress, and community-minded thinking.

Gemini: The Twins



- **Air, mutable, “I Think”**
- **The conscious mind**
- **Communicative**
- **Curious, playful**
- **Social, adaptable**
- **Shadow: indecisive, restless, inconsistent, scattered**

Uranus has just entered Gemini, a mutable air sign associated with the conscious mind, education, communication, and travel. Its key phrase is, “I Think,” and its symbol is The Twins. Gemini has a curious, mercurial nature that seeks to understand and exchange ideas. It governs flexibility, versatility, and mental agility.

At its best, Gemini is social, adaptable, communicative, and playful—eager to explore both ideas and experiences. In its shadow expression, it can become indecisive, inconsistent, restless, and scattered.

Uranus in Gemini: Freedom, Innovation

Freedom: The American Revolutionary War, The Civil War, The Declaration of Independence signed, WWII

Innovation: Transatlantic cable laid, birth of the printing press, US post office, telescope, steam engine, phonograph, and computers

In the past, Uranus in Gemini created an inner push to revolt for freedom and it brought forth innovations that profoundly changed our world. You'll note the similarities between this and Pluto in Aquarius. That's because Uranus rules Aquarius so we have similar undertones of rebellion for freedom and innovation. Revolutions and wars include The American Revolutionary War, the Civil War, and WWII.

Innovations include the laying of the transatlantic cable which permitted quick communication between America and Europe. This transformed business, diplomacy, and became the foundation for today's global communications networks.

Other Uranus in Gemini innovations that changed our world include the printing press, the US post office, the telescope, steam engine and computers. These revolutionized communication, education, and travel, all ruled by Gemini.

Uranus in Gemini

4/26 – 5/33



- **Communication revolution**
- **Intellectual breakthroughs**
- **Social rebellion, activism**
- **Personal transformation**

Uranus re-entered Gemini earlier this week and remains there until 2033. This marks a period of sweeping revolution and bold innovation, especially in communication, technology and social thought.

- Prepare for groundbreaking changes in how we communicate and exchange information. One is artificial intelligence which will redefine how we communicate, think and act
- Expect major advancements in science, medicine, education, and technology.
- Social rebellion and activism will increase and focus on equality and freedom
- Personal Transformation — On a personal level, you may experience a profound shift in how you see the world, how you communicate and a strong desire to learn or teach something new.

In a nutshell, Uranus in Gemini signals significant upheaval followed by freedom, innovation and awakening to the new.

Uranus and Pluto are now aligned in a powerful trine, signaling a rare period of cooperation between these two titans. While this transit spans roughly six years, it's peak intensity is between July 2025 and July 2028.

We can expect lasting change that grows from the courage to transform. We'll see lasting transformation in our government, technology and collective empowerment. In your personal life, this transit gives access to potentials you either didn't know you had or haven't had the opportunity to use, along with courage, creativity and the ability to make lasting change for the better in your life.

This is a time where you can make bold changes, and make them stick.

Neptune in Aries January 2026 – March 2039

Thanks Camille! I'd like to discuss Neptune having moved into the sign of Aries. We got a taste of this energy last spring. Neptune went retrograde over the summer and this past January, re-entered Aries where it will remain until March 2039.

Neptune takes about 14 years to transit each sign, so this is a major shift. Let's explore this change starting with discussing the core energy of Neptune itself.



Neptune: The Dissolver

- Inspiration and creativity
- Intuition and psychic abilities
- Spirituality and mysticism
- Compassion and empathy
- Dreams and imagination
- Healing and purification
- Illusion, deception, escapism, and addiction

Neptune is often called the Great Dissolver because it breaks down boundaries, loosens the grip of the ego, and merges us with something larger than ourselves.

This planet governs inspiration, creativity, and all forms of artistic expression—music, film, dance, painting, and poetry to name just a few. It also heightens intuition, making us more sensitive to subtle energies and inner guidance.

Being the planet of spirituality and mysticism, it connects us to a sense of oneness and higher purpose. It also brings compassion, empathy, and a more forgiving, heart-centered way of relating to others. Neptune rules our dreams, imagination, and the subconscious, as well as themes of healing and spiritual purification.

On the challenging side, it can blur reality, leading to confusion, illusion or even addiction. So it really works both ways—it can elevate us spiritually or pull us into escapism.

Now let's look at the qualities associated with the sign of Aries.

Aries: The Ram

- **Fire, cardinal, “I Am”**
- **Courageous, bold**
- **Passionate, action-oriented**
- **Direct, focused, determined**
- **Independent, optimistic**
- **Aggressive, impatient, quick-tempered**



Aries is a Cardinal Fire sign, and its key phrase is “I Am.” As a cardinal sign, it marks the beginning of a new season—spring—and carries that energy of initiation, leadership, and forward movement.

Aries energy is courageous and bold. It's passionate, action-oriented, and likes to move quickly. It's direct, focused, and determined, with a strong sense of independence and natural optimism.

When out of balance that same fiery energy can come across as impulsive, impatient, aggressive or quick-tempered.

So, let's look at what we can expect with Neptune in the sign of Aries.

Neptune in Aries

1/26 – 3/39



- **Spiritual awakening**
- **Creative inspiration**
- **Impulsive action**
- **Technological advancements in the Arts, virtual reality**

When Neptune moves through Aries, there's this noticeable push toward spiritual awakening and self-discovery. People start exploring new ideas, new beliefs, and new ways of seeing the world. There's also a big wave of creative inspiration. It's not just about imagining things—it's about actually wanting to bring those visions to life and express them, especially through art or creative outlets. Be aware this combination can be a bit tricky. Neptune's dreamy idealism mixed with Aries' impulsive energy can lead to exciting breakthroughs—but also a few missteps if we're not staying grounded.

This energy will support technological advancements in the arts such as enhanced virtual reality and immersive creative experiences.

So, this transit is really about finding that balance between vision and action—taking inspiration and turning it into something real, both for our own personal growth and for the collective.

Next, let's shift gears and talk about another significant change with the planet Saturn.



Saturn in Aries February 2026 – April 2028

As of this past February, Saturn entered Aries, where it will remain until April 2028.



Saturn: The Great Teacher and Manifestor

- Gives birth in the physical world to our thoughts, words, and actions
- Manifests thoughts into form at their proper time
- Provides the lessons we need to grow and understand

Saturn is often called the Great Teacher and Manifestor because she gives birth in the physical world to our thoughts, words, and actions. When an astrologer looks at your chart, Saturn is one of the first influences they examine because it shows what is being activated in everyday life. While Pluto, Neptune, and Uranus reflect deeper foundational energies, Saturn reveals how those energies take form in practical reality.

Saturn is associated with karma and the law of cause and effect. It is the force that helps turn ideas into tangible results. For example, if you intend to manifest something in your life, Saturn is what helps that intention become real in the physical world, in its proper time. Because Saturn limits, structures, and defines, it also teaches patience, responsibility, and timing.

In this sense, Saturn is the great teacher: we reap what we sow, and we learn through the consequences of our choices, actions, and attitudes. Saturn gives us the lessons we need in order to grow in wisdom and maturity.

Aries: The Ram

We just talked about the qualities of Aries energy when we were talking about Neptune. So that same energy is now applicable to Saturn being in Aries.

Saturn in Aries 2/26 – 4/28

- **Disciplined courage**
- **Leadership and accountability**
- **Identity restructuring**
- **Action with purpose**
- **Building something real**



Saturn is in Aries from this past February through April 2028. Its about turning bold starts into sustainable action with a strong emphasis on responsibility, leadership and personal accountability. Aries wants to act fast, while Saturn asks for patience, planning and follow-through. Impulse is not enough, our choices need intention, structure and staying power.

As I mentioned, the key words for Aries is I AM as it rules our individuality, so Saturn here can reshape confidence, self-image and how we assert ourselves. We are supported with a greater sense of self-discipline...It's the perfect opportunity to focus on starting a new fitness routine and improving our health. This is a strong period for accomplishing long-term goals and personal mastery.

Saturn reminds us to stay mindful of Aries' shadow side—things like ego, arrogance, and impulsive aggression. Its deeper lesson is about transforming those raw, reactive tendencies into something more conscious. It guides us toward greater inner balance and a stronger sense of unity with those around us.

Shifting gears again...Let's talk about the Lunar Nodes changing signs.

Lunar Nodes Change Signs into Aquarius (NN) and Leo (SN) July 2026 – March 2028

The Lunar Nodes will change signs into Aquarius and Leo at the end of July. Let me explain what the Nodes are and how they operate. And then we can look at their influence in these signs.

Lunar Nodes: Soul's Journey

South Node: Past-life karma, resolving problems

- **Over-developed**
- **Familiar patterns**
- **Ingrained habits**

North Node: Evolutionary direction, progress

- **Direction of growth**
- **Future focus**
- **What the soul is developing in this lifetime**

What are the Lunar Nodes? They are two invisible points where the Moon's orbit crosses the Sun's path, which is known as the ecliptic. They are not physical bodies like planets, but rather calculated points that move through the entire zodiac in an 18- to 19-year cycle, spending about a year and a half in each sign. In modern astrology, the Nodes are often seen as part of the soul's journey or karmic path. There are always two—the North Node and the South Node—and they sit directly opposite each other.

In our birth chart, they point to our personal path of growth in this lifetime. Together, they form a kind of life axis. The South Node reflects patterns and traits we're already familiar with and have overdone in the past, while the North Node shows where we're being encouraged to grow and stretch.

On a personal level, your Nodes tell the story of your individual soul's journey. In today's sky, the placement of the lunar nodes speaks to the collective—highlighting the direction of all mankind's evolutionary path.

North Node Aquarius, South Node Leo July 2026 – March 2028

South Node in Leo: Release old patterns

In late July, the lunar nodes change signs, with the North Node moving into Aquarius and the South Node into Leo. This marks a collective shift with our new focus toward community, innovation, and a shared sense of purpose.

We're being invited to connect with others, contribute to something larger than ourselves, and bring our unique ideas and gifts into group settings that support the greater good.

At the same time, the South Node in Leo highlights patterns we're ready to move beyond—like the need for personal recognition, approval, or being at the center of attention. It's about releasing ego-driven expression and balancing that with a more group-focused, collaborative approach.

The past is over—what do you want now in your life? Where do you want to go? This is a time of writing yourself a new chapter.

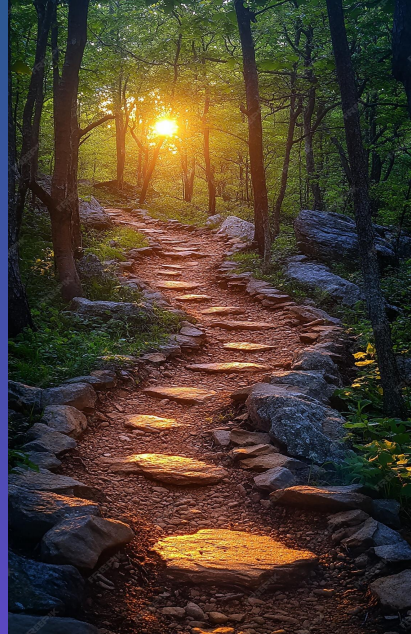
Don't hesitate, decide and then take the steps to begin. Today's energies fuel a willingness to trust your instincts before the path is fully visible. A clear path will unfold in time.
